Dear Parents/Carers,

It is the time of year again for the annual **Dads' Big Tidy Up!** We have had fantastic support in the last couple of years from Dads, Granddads, Uncles and not to be sexist, some Mums too! We are hoping to get the outside area in front of Robins' class spruced up and part of the School House Garden fit for purpose as well as doing some projects like ensuring Barn Owls' outdoor classroom doesn't get too slippery as winter approaches. Obviously, alongside this, there are always leaves to sweep up! So, if you or anyone you know is up for some painting, digging, sweeping and laying of turf, to name just a few of the jobs, do please come along on the afternoon of Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> November to lend a hand. Our FOGS fundraising events are massively valuable but this event is also a huge help to the school and saves us a lot of money that we can spend on the children's education.

We have a few events coming up during November:

On **Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November**, we are opening the school to all parents to come and see how KS2 maths is taught now in our school (please see attached flyer). This event should be valuable whatever class your child is currently in. It will hopefully be very interesting and we promise not to put any parents on the spot to start multiplying fractions!

Following the success of our 'Reading STARS' certificates in raising reading standards across the school, we will be launching our 'Maths Wizards' certificates on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November. Check your child's book bag (Year 1 upwards) for their brand new 'Maths Wizards' home/ school book and challenge card on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November.

Maths Wizards, for Year One upwards, works in a similar way to Reading STARS; children are expected to practise the maths skills on their challenge card every evening for five to ten minutes, and record how many times they have practised in a week in their Maths Wizards home/school book. Certificates are awarded for practising ten, twenty-five, fifty times and so on, and are presented in assembly in the same way that reading certificates are.

The success of Reading STARS was largely due to the children reading each evening at home and the support of parents. We ask that parents help us to make Maths Wizards a huge success; practising basic maths skills each evening will improve your child's maths understanding enormously. This will replace any maths homework that is currently sent out and along with reading, spelling and in KS2, thought diaries, will form the main homework for children throughout the school.

Please see your child's class teacher with any queries or come along to our maths workshop afternoon at 2pm, next Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> November to find out more.

On **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November**, it is Children In Need Day and we are asking children to come dressed in their own clothes for a donation to the charity. There will be an **assembly** at 9 a.m. led by KS2 children talking about the Rights of the Child - do come along and listen to what the children have been finding out about over the last few months.

We will be holding a Book Fair in school for one week starting 30 November. If you are able to help run it after school, do please speak to Mrs Sawyer. We get free books for the school in commission and were able to get some new KS2 reading books last year plus some new texts for guided reading.

It has been great to welcome our new teacher, Mrs Oram into Robins class this week and we look forward to welcoming Mrs Godfree as full time teaching assistant into Barn Owls' class shortly. We wish Mrs Taggart and Mrs Leeson the best of luck in their exciting new futures as we say goodbye to them today. We look forward to meeting Taggart Junior shortly!
