



Glaphorn C.E. Primary School Uniform Rules

We encourage all pupils to be smartly attired in school. The school colour is bottle green and clothing should be appropriate and practical so that pupils can participate safely in all activities undertaken. All uniform should be named.

School Uniform

- Boys - grey trousers, white shirt or polo shirt, bottle green sweatshirt or jersey. Shorts may be worn in hot weather
- Girls - grey skirt, trousers, culottes or pinafore, white blouse or white polo shirt, bottle green cardigan or sweatshirt. Summer dresses - green and white check - may be worn in hot weather.

All the above items are readily available from chain stores at a reasonable cost. Uniform and PE kit, printed with 'Glaphorn School' may also be ordered through the school.

Children should wear black, flat shoes, not boots.

Physical Education (P.E.) and Sporting Activities:

Throughout the week children should keep in school a P.E. kit. This should include:

- Green t-shirt
- Black shorts
- Trainers

It is important that children have a change of footwear if working outside to ensure they can participate safely and reduce the amount of dirt coming into school.

During the colder months children should wear additional tracksuits and sweatshirts, preferably black or dark in colour.

Jewellery

Children should not wear any jewellery in school unless it is for religious or particular sentimental reasons, to be agreed in discussion with the Head Teacher.

If children have their ears pierced they should only wear plain studs. To participate in physical activities parental permission is required so that plasters can be put over studs in newly pierced ears.

All jewellery must be removed for P.E. and sporting activities.
